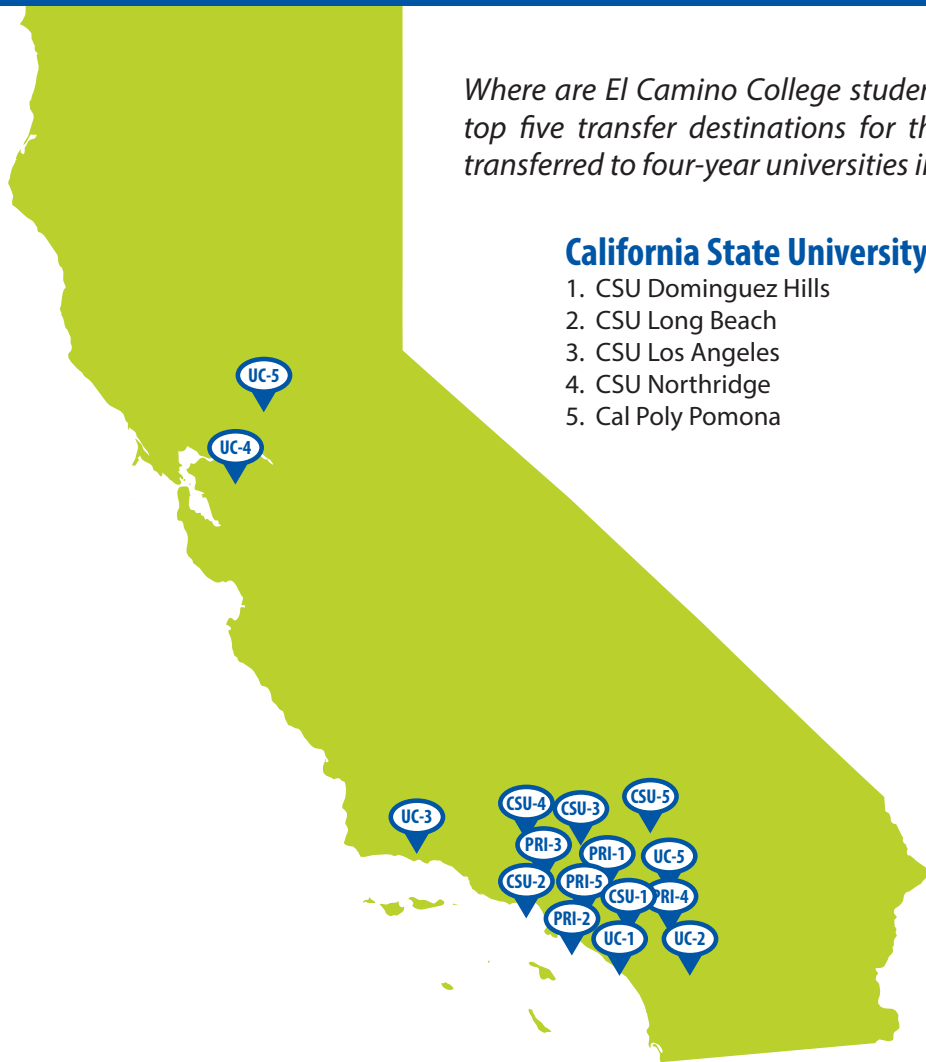
Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) Programs

Honors Transfer Program

Highly motivated students are encouraged to join our Honors Transfer Program (HTP), which prepares students to transfer to a university. Benefits include: priority registration for ECC classes, designation of HTP on transcripts, as well as additional scholarship opportunities. In 2016, 150 HTP students transferred to universities such as UCLA and UC Berkeley.





STUDENT SUCCESS & SUPPORT

Counseling and Support

El Camino College offers specialized support, no matter what your needs may be. On campus, we have our Special Resource Center, International Students Program, Veterans Resource Center, Transfer Center, EOPS, CalWORKS and CARE programs, and more.

Library & Learning Resources

The Schauerman Library includes excellent traditional, online and multimedia resources, providing the tools you need to meet the academic rigor of your classes. The Learning Resource Center offers academic support services and resources – tutoring, instructional software, media materials, and open-access computer labs – at no cost to ECC students.

Tutoring & Academic Assistance

The Learning Resource Center Tutorial Program offers free drop-in tutoring on a variety of subjects. The Writing Center serves ECC students who need assistance with writing. The Reading Success Center offers free one-on-one tutoring, computer access, and topic-specific workshops. The Math Study Center and computer lab provide a place to study math, one-on-one tutoring, and access to mathematical software.

Computer Labs

Our campus is equipped with several computer labs, each with Internet access. There is also secure wireless access over 95% of the campus.

Student Health

The ECC Health Services Center provides primary health care services and workshops on health-related issues. Short-term psychological counseling is also available, free of charge.

Career Services

The Career Center provides ECC students with the resources for career exploration, internships, and employment assistance.

Excellent Faculty

Our world-class faculty gives El Camino College a stellar academic reputation, and helps us continue to recruit outstanding instructors. At ECC, no matter what courses you take, you'll study with accomplished scholars and noted professionals.

Student Activities

El Camino College Offers an Excellent Education at the Best Value

It costs California residents only about \$1,400 per year to attend El Camino College. We offer the same general education courses as UC and CSU schools – and students save thousands of dollars. In fact, students can earn their bachelor's degree with half the amount of student debt just by starting at ECC and then transferring to a four-year college or university.

A full-time student enrolled in 12 units for two semesters pays \$1,400 per year in enrollment fees at El Camino College, in comparison to:

APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Take the first step – it's fast and easy! Complete and submit your free application online.

- New and returning students (those with an absence of two consecutive primary terms: fall or spring semesters; excluding summer and winter terms) must complete an online application for admission.
- A Student ID number will be issued and emailed upon completion of the online application.
- Official transcripts from all accredited colleges and trade schools attended must be submitted by those schools to the El Camino College Records Office. Students applying for Advanced Placement credit must submit official high school transcripts.
