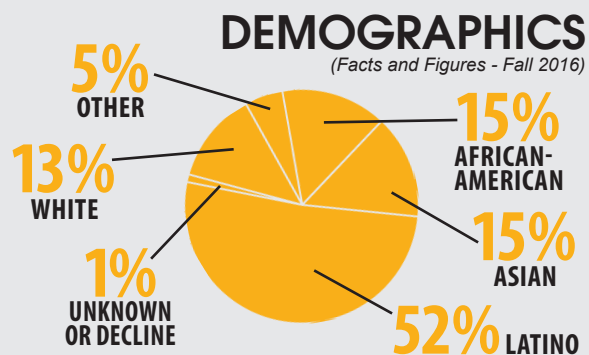
## Program Highlights
