## Liberal Studies Early Teaching and Learning Option

The **Liberal Studies Early Teaching and Learning Option (ETLO)** is designed to prepare students to teach children from birth to age five in diverse inclusive early childhood education and preschool settings. Participants in the option complete the undergraduate Liberal Studies degree with an emphasis on studies in early language development, culture, literacy, and early mathematical reasoning. For those students interested in special education, the option provides a clear pathway into the Early Childhood Special Education credential program.

**It is highly recommended that all students meet with the Seeds Head Start Counselor to create an Education Plan.**
