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**Spring Enrollments**

Miranda distributed copies of the renumbered list of history courses and asked the department to consider a rotation sequence for area courses and submit a pattern that can be used in future scheduling to the division office. There are a number of new courses as well as existing area history classes that should be made available to students on a sequential basis.

**Program Review**

G. Miranda distributed copies of the 2010-11 department plans for departmental review and future reorganization of goals and objectives. E. Rader initiated a discussion on the direction of the department including collaboration, leadership and other topics. A discussion ensued on this initial dialogue.

**History Club**

F. Baker was not present at the department meeting because of her attendance at the History Club gathering. The club apparently has a solid core of student members with more meetings planned as well as collaboration with the History Department.

**MBBM/CTO Issues**

A. Verge reported that his sinus condition has flared up severely due to the recycled air in MBBM 133. The heat and cold air in the modules is not consistent and cycles off erratically at times. C. Gold stated

that tiles are missing in MBBM 105, duct work is needed, and she has limited whiteboard space in her classroom as well. G. Miranda will seek to have a larger whiteboard installed in her classroom.
