  - B. Draft Spring 2015 Assessment Schedule
    - The draft of the Spring 2015 Assessment Schedule was reviewed.
    - Reps were asked to inform D. L. Hayden if there are any corrections to faculty assigned to complete assessments.
    - Reps will let faculty know if they are responsible for completing an SLO.
- II. DISCUSSION/ACTIONS
  - A. Fall 2014 SLO Assessments
    - 1. Workroom poster initials

    - 3. Multiple-section course assessments
      - F. Sadeghi-Tabrizi explained how to complete assessments for courses with multiple sections.
      - The random sample size should be at least 10% of the total number of students across all sections, however a larger sample size is always better.
    - 4.PLO assessment plans
      - A 2-prong approach is not necessary for courses that build on themselves.
      - Courses that do not build on themselves should use a 2-prong approach.
      - F. Sadeghi-Tabrizi suggested having a common rubric and assignment in place for assessments.
