

TRANSER STUDENTS

Transfer students are considered students who have been enrolled in another BRN-accredited nursing program. Students interested in transferring to El Camino College (ECC) Associate Degree Nursing program **will not** be accepted for admission consideration beyond the second semester. In addition, the students must have met all of the required admission criteria in order to be eligible to enter the nursing program.

Potential candidates will need to submit an Appeal for Admission Application for admission consideration to the nursing department, the package is available in the nursing department office. The appeals process is available to students who are in good standing at their previous enrolled BRN-accredited nursing program; however are ineligible to return to the program. The appeals process must be resolved before further consideration of the application is possible.

The Admission, Transfer and Progression (ATP) committee will evaluate your application to determine eligibility. Potential candidates must complete the NURS 144 (formerly N4 48) Dosage Calculation course at ECC to be considered eligible for admission consideration to the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) program. In addition, potential candidates must have attended an information session within 1 year of seeking approval to transfer to the ECC ADN program. Admission consideration to the nursing program is based on space availability.

Credit for nursing courses completed at another college will be evaluated on an individual basis by the Director of Nursing or the Director's designee. Credit can be achieved through the petition process as well. The Director of Nursing or the Director's designee will be responsible for evaluation the semester in which you are admitted to the program. After the appeals application has been approved by the ATP committee, eligible individuals approved for admission will be required to enroll and complete **NURS 149 Advanced Placement in Nursing** with a "C" or better, before transferring into the semester in which the candidates has been approved.
