ECC Scholarships

Greetings from the El Camino College Scholarship Office. We encourage you to register and apply for El Camino College Scholarships. Available scholarships are both need and merit based and open to all students. Applicants must be on the path to a two-year degree, certificate or transfer to a four-year institution.

Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ Six units of graded El Camino College coursework.
- ◆ Grade point average of 2.0 or better
- ◆ One letter of recommendation
- ◆ A personal essay

Total graded units and minimum GPA will be considered during the selection phase of the application process. You may apply if the units are in progress.

Please check your e-mail regularly for updates from the scholarship office.

How to apply

The El Camino College scholarship application can be accessed at El Camino College Portal (MyECC).

Step 1-Registration

Login to the El Camino College Portal (MyECC) and click on the link “Scholarship Application.” The link is located under the “Student Info” tab under the heading “WebServices–Students.” Complete the registration form and click “Register Now.”

Step 2-Account Activation

Check your El Camino College e-mail for an account activation message from the Scholarship Office. Once you have received the activation e-mail, you may apply for scholarships. All students using the program must have an El Camino portal ID.

Step 3-Apply for Scholarships

Login to the El Camino College Portal (MyECC) and click on the link “Scholarship Application.” The scholarship program will display a menu of options for you to choose from. Click the “Apply for Scholarships” link. A list of scholarships will appear. Clicking on the name of the scholarship will display a listing of all questions you must answer to be considered for an award. You are highly encouraged to apply for all scholarships marked with a star.

Registration

Step 4-Submit Letter of Recommendation

Visit the El Camino College Scholarship Office and submit your letter of recommendation as soon as possible. Do not forget this important step, students who do not have a letter of recommendation on file will not be considered for scholarship awards.

Step 5-Awards

Check your El Camino College e-mail for an award notice message from the El Camino Scholarship Office. Upon receiving an award, you may click on the “RSVP” link on the scholarship program menu to reserve your seat at the award ceremony.

PAYMENT

All scholarships are disbursed after verification of enrollment. El Camino College scholarships are applied toward student tuition, books, fees, parking and required supplies. Students do not receive cash awards unless it is specifically stipulated by the donor (s).
