Application Filing Period is March 16 to April 5, 2017

DIRECTIONS & Instructions for Filing an Application to the Radiologic Technology Program

- 1. Print out the 4 page 2017 RT Application form available on the RT website (Please keep in the <u>LANDSCAPE</u> format -Portrait not accepted)

 The applicant must fill out pages 1 & 4; the Health Science counselors will complete pages 2 & 3 during the counseling appointment.
- 2. Review <u>all</u> of the information contained within the **2017 RT Program Application Information packet**.

 This packet provides an explanation of what is required and how to file an application to the R. T. program.
- 3. Review the 2017 RT Program Application Checklist and Worksheet section to learn how to earn the additional points on the application.

 Use the checklist provided to be sure that you have submitted all of the required documents for the application.

 Missing information or incomplete applications will not be considered for review.
- **4.** Fill out the **2017 RT Program Application Course Evaluation** page to confirm that you have completed the required prerequisites. All required pre-requisite course work must be <u>completed</u> with a minimum GPA of 2.25 <u>before</u> you can submit the application.
- 5. Make an appointment to meet with one of the Health Science counselors (Janice Pon-Ishikawa, Kelsey Iino, Chris Jeffries or Stephanie Bennett) between March 16 to April 5, 2017. Check the RT website for the "RT Applicant drop in counseling appointment schedule".
- **6.** You must have completed <u>all</u> required documentation and ready to submit an application to the program, at the time of the counseling appointment. Your final step to file the application is to meet with a counselor and have your coursework and GPA evaluated (RT Application form pages 2 & 3). At the completion of your appointment, you will submit your application to the counselor for consideration.
- **7.** Arrange to send official transcripts <u>by mail</u> prior to your appointment, bring copies of all relevant transcripts with you to the appointment DO NOT send your transcripts to the Radiologic Technology Program only to the Admissions Office.
- **8.** Your application will be forwarded to the Radiologic Technology faculty for evaluation and ranking. Page 4 and the supporting documentation will be reviewed to determine how many additional points you may be awarded on your application by the RT Faculty.
- **9.** After filing your application, <u>you must</u> send Mrs. Charman (Program Director) an email with your information (see instructions) to complete the application. You will be notified of your ranking <u>via your El Camino email address</u> by Mrs. Charman by **May 1, 2017.**
- **10.** Keep a copy of your documents, your application will not be returned.

Application Instructions –

To file an Application to the Radiologic Technology Program for Fall 2017 – you must complete the following requirements:

- 1. You must be registered as an El Camino College student to obtain an ECC student ID # and an ECC email address for the application.
- 2. You may register on line follow the instructions under the RT Program Application Worksheet Checklist section.
- 3. Fill out the Worksheet Checklist to ensure you have submitted all required documents for the application & bring to counseling appointment.
- 4. All required course work must be completed with a minimum **GPA of 2.25** to file an application. (see RT Application pg. 2 for details)
- 5. Read this entire Application Information packet and all forms <u>carefully</u>, to be sure that you can receive the <u>maximum points possible</u>.
- 6. Collect all the necessary paperwork required to be eligible to receive all points possible on the Radiologic Technology Application.
- 7. Be sure to submit all required application documents, (keep a copy of all documents submitted) at the time of your counseling appointment.
- 8. Any documents submitted after April 5, 2017 will NOT be considered.
- 9. Make <u>copies</u> of any supporting documents you <u>submit</u> (ex: a copy of your XT Certificate not the original certificate)
- 10. The 2017 application and supporting documents will not be returned.

Other Requirements:

- 1. <u>Social Security Number</u>: The state of California, Department of Public Health, Radiologic Health Branch requires a graduate from an accredited Diagnostic Radiologic Technology program to have a <u>valid social security number</u> to be eligible to take the licensing exams for Radiology and Fluoroscopy. In addition, a social security number is required to complete the mandatory background check prior to acceptance into the program. Radiologic Technology applicants <u>may be</u> required to <u>show proof</u> of a valid social security number prior to acceptance into the radiology program. <u>You DO NOT have to submit a copy of your social security card</u>. Only include the last four digits of your number on the application.
- 2. <u>Photo Identification card</u>: For purposes of identification verification, applicants will be required to submit a <u>clear copy</u> of a current <u>California</u>

 <u>Driver's License (CDL) or State issued ID card</u> with the application. Accepted applicants will also be required to provide proof of a valid <u>El Camino</u>

 College Student ID card during the second orientation session prior to acceptance into the program.
- 3. <u>Cover letter and Resume</u> As part of the application process, each applicant is required to submit a one page cover letter explaining their interest and commitment to become a part of the El Camino College Radiologic Technology Program. In addition, the applicant is required to include a one page resume, describing at a minimum, their educational background, work history to include any health care or military experience (if any).
- 4. <u>Letter of Recommendation</u> Applicants are required to submit <u>ONE</u> professional letter of recommendation to the program with the application. The letter must be written within <u>2 years from the date of application</u>. Letters dated later than 2 years will not be accepted. Letter must be dated. Character references must be on letterhead stationary and/or attached business card of the person writing the recommendation letter. Letter must include a signature with the writer's contact information. Professional or Business references not personal (family or friends)

 Letter may be from an employer, supervisor, professor with a lab class, or counselor. If there is no date or signature, it will not be accepted.

Application Review Procedure and Notification of Acceptance:

- **1.** All completed applications will be reviewed and ranked by the Radiologic Technology Application Committee, based on the multi-criteria points system on the application.
- 2. Applicants will be notified by the R T Program Director, Dawn Charman, or faculty via their El Camino email address on or before May 1, 2017, if the application has received sufficient points to make the "top 35" or not.
- 3. The top 20 24 applications will be offered a conditional acceptance for a position in the FALL 2017 Radiologic Technology Class.
- 4. The remaining #25 30 applicants will be ranked as <u>possible alternates</u> for the Fall 2017 class. If someone from the top 24 declines the position on or before Sep 1, 2017- the next ranked applicant on the alternate list will be offered a provisional position.
- **5.** All top 30 applicants will be expected to reply via email to the Program Director, that they either <u>accept or decline the offer</u> by the deadline posted in the email. The "top 30" will be expected to attend the first of two summer mandatory orientation sessions.
- **6.** Upon receipt of the applicant's acceptance email, the applicant will be provided information about the Mandatory Orientations that are held during the Summer 2017 semester. The dates of the orientation will be posted on the website.
- 7. Failure to send an email reply by the specified date, or failure to attend the mandatory summer orientation, will result in the removal of the applicant's name from the applicant pool.
- **8.** Once an applicant attends the mandatory orientation, and has successfully completed all required paperwork (background check and physical health exam, etc.) the offer converts from a conditional placement to a confirmed placement in the program beginning **Aug. 29, 2017**.

Previous applications

Applicants who have previously applied to the ECC RT Program should clearly indicate on page 1 of the Application form all previous application dates for possible consideration in the event of a tie-breaker.

Applicants not accepted for 2017

- If the application does not rank in the top 40, then the applicant should review page 5, item #M, on the Worksheet Checklist below for suggestions on how to improve your GPA and application points for the next application filing period.
- You may also contact the Program Director to set an appointment, have an email consultation, or schedule a visit during office hours on how to improve your points for the next application period.

 - For ESL Students, ESL 51B or 51 C is recommended to improve communication skills & success in the program (no additional points)
