HTP COURSE REQUIREMENT

You must register for an <u>honors section</u> listed on the handout. HTP students must complete <u>at</u> <u>least one</u> honors course each semester (some students take more than one per semester), for a total of five honors courses to complete the program. Students should consult with a counselor to ensure that they take the appropriate courses for their major and transfer institution. Many of these courses are offered during both the fall and spring semesters, and some may be offered during the summer session. Winter session is discontinued.

New HTP students are required to take English 1A their first semester in the program, unless English 1A has already been completed or has been waived by AP exam. Taking an honors section of English 1A is recommended. The HTP currently offers three English courses, three history courses, and four communication studies courses; however, no more than two courses in the same department may count toward the five honors courses required to complete the program.

The STEM-course policy has changed. The HTP will no longer give honors credit for non-honors sections of certain science and math courses. For students joining the HTP after spring 2013, all five of your honors courses must be honors-designated sections, as listed on this handout. As with all other honors courses, no more than two courses in the same department will count as honors. Honors-designated STEM courses will have a T (honors notation) on the ECC transcript, consistent with all other honors courses.

Students already in the HTP will not be affected by this change, and will continue to follow the former STEM-course policy. However, students who are suspended from the program for any reason will be subject to the new policy upon reinstatement.
