## YOU NEED TO KNOW THESE THINGS ABOUT WORKSHOPS

- You will lose your priority registration if you do not attend at least one workshop <u>every semester</u>.
- Write down each workshop you attend on the HTP Completion Form in your Handbook. You will receive credit only for workshops that you record accurately.
- You do <u>not</u> need to sign up for workshops in advance.
- Arrive at the workshop on time, according to the clock in the workshop room. If you are late, the door will be locked and you will <u>not</u> be admitted. <u>Why take a</u> <u>chance</u>? <u>Arrive early and get a good seat</u>!
- Stay for the full time (50 minutes). You cannot leave the room and then return.
- Sign the attendance sheet after the workshop is over. No signature = no credit.
- No food or beverages are allowed in workshop rooms.
- Turn off all electronic devices.
- Listen to the speaker. No talking, texting, reading, studying, or disturbing others.
- If we add another workshop, we will email you.
- Transfer Center workshops are <u>not</u> HTP workshops.
- You may attend more than one workshop in a single semester, and they will all count, but you cannot "bank" a workshop for a future semester. Every semester you must attend at least one, until you have completed four.
- You should receive an email message from HTP about once a week during the fall and spring semesters. Emails are sent to your ECC email address only, and emails that the HTP secretary sends to the <u>entire</u> HTP membership are printed and posted on the bulletin board between offices 102F and 102G.
