Spring 2017 SLO and PLO report

SLO reports were due in TracDat on Friday, September 15, 2017

Missing reports (PLO and SLO) for Spring 2017

Committee D is missing math 23 and 80 SLO. CM2 is missing a report for math 130 SLO and PLO. Engineering SLO is completed. PLO is 4/5 done. The Computer Science reports are complete.

All SLOs and PLOs should be completed and submitted as soon as possible.

Common Omission (from submitted reports)

Action items are not identified. Action is too broad. Due dates for action items are not updated making the follow up due as soon as the report is entered. Instructors providing feedback is still an issue. Committee members explained how they repeatedly email instructors but they often get no response. One committee member recommended also having a conversation with instructors for feedback. S. Bucher explained that for math 40, after actions are discussed, she will send out reports to past spring and current fall math 40 instructors to look at the actions. S. Bucher plans to also send the SLO reports to those being evaluated so they may have something to discuss regarding SLOs and their self-evaluations. Another suggestion was to create a document that includes all of the actions from all of the committees and send this out for feedback. For report analysis, a summary is recommended rather than cutting and pasting the answers provided by instructors. Information should be more generalized to the common mistakes of most of the students. For example, what part of the problem did most do incorrectly.
