

Elementary Algebra Courses for Fall 2009

Mathematics 33-43* Extended Elementary Algebra A two-semester sequence of courses	Mathematics 40 Elementary Algebra A one-semester course
Reviews more pre-algebra	Starts right off with elementary algebra
Starts at a slower pace, increasing over the two semesters, and ends at a college-level pace	Starts right off at a college-level pace
Placement level: a score of 70-120 on the Arithmetic Placement Test AND a score of 30-69 on the Algebra Placement Test	Placement level: a score 74-120 on the Arithmetic Placement Test AND a score 45-69 on the Algebra Placement Test
Recommended for students with a C in Math 23	Recommended for students with an A or a B in Math 23
Each of Math 33 and Math 43 is a 3-unit, 4-hour course	Math 40 is a 4-unit, 4-hour course, requiring approximately 8 hours studying per week
Each of Math 33 and Math 43 requires approximately 5 hours studying per week	Math 40 requires approximately 8 hours studying per week
Students who complete Math 33-43 or Math 40 with a C or better are eligible to enroll in Intermediate Algebra (either Math 73 or Math 80)
