- Responsible for maintaining updated parent release forms for all children enrolled in the after-school program
- Assist in completion of daily homework and tutoring
- Responsible for developing daily curriculum for appropriate school-aged children
- Document all incident reports and report them to the proper authority
- Prepare and issue snacks to all children in attendance
- Complete and give daily statistical data to Director of Education
- Oversee video selection and operation of TV and VCR
- Supervise daily activities including, but not limited to, art, cooking, science, and outside play
- Clean up and close the program at the end of each day
- Responsible for guaranteeing that all children are signed out at the end of each day and picked up only by person(s) listed in their file
- Work part-time schedule
- Other duties as assigned
