Our child care center provides a nurturing and emotionally secure environment to help children achieve their full potential and enable their parents to take steps toward self-sufficiency, knowing their children are in quality care.

Purpose of Position: To plan and implement developmentally appropriate programming for children ages 2 ½ -5 years old while ensuring their safety and overall well-being.

Major Duties:

- Establish and maintain a safe, secure, and healthful environment for children at all times.
- Supervise assigned group of children and be aware of total classroom/playground situation at all times.
- Plan and implement developmentally appropriate activities according to the individual and small group needs as well as their interests; including, but not limited to language, art, music, science, math, gross and fine motor movement.
- Consistently use positive guidance and classroom management techniques.
- Develop and maintain positive relationships with families.
- Serve as an educational resource to parents and community.
- Close the Preschool classroom at the end of the day.
- Prepare and help serve snack to all children in the preschool classroom.
- Verify that only authorized individuals are taking children from the center.
- Verify that children have been correctly signed out at the end of the day.
- Maintain knowledge of and compliance with Title 22 regulations.

Required Qualifications:

1. Minimum of 12 units in Child Development/Early Childhood Education
2. Minimum of 1 year experience working with children in a licensed child care facility
3. Pediatric CPR & First Aid Training
4. Current negative TB test
5. Professional level knowledge of educational theory, child development, and teaching skills

This position is full-time, Monday-Friday.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
