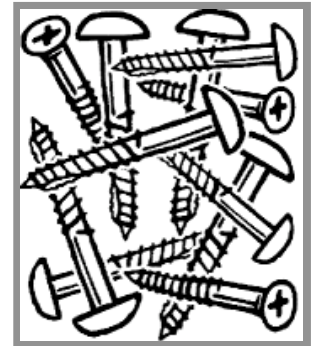

## Internships for the Fall

If you want to be a CTE teacher at the high school level, are an El Camino College student, are in our program, and are enrolled in at least six units, you are eligible for a paid internship. We can place you in a high school CTE course to work with students under the supervision of a master teacher.

If you are interested in an internship please stop by our office, fill out an application and set an appointment for an interview. There are a limited number of internships, so apply soon.



## What is the CTE Teacher Pipeline?

The Career and Technical Education (CTE) Teacher Pipeline is a program funded by a grant from the California State Chancellor for Community Colleges. We help El Camino College students and the general community to become teachers in CTE areas at the middle school, high school, adult education and college levels.

CTE areas are those that teach students trades or vocations. At the high school level this could be a general subject area like industrial arts, or a specific area like woodworking, auto mechanics or even robotics.

We can help students understand the requirements needed to teach at different levels including different state credentials and academic degrees.

## CSULA Cross Enrollment Course

If you want to become an industrial arts teacher at a middle school or high school we have a program for you! You can get your bachelor's degree and your single subject teaching credential at California State University, Los Angeles in industrial technology education.

To help you make the transition from ECC to CSULA we can offer you one of the CSULA courses in this program taught here on ECC campus, at ECC prices, by a CSULA instructor. You earn CSULA credit and get a CSULA transcript.

To be eligible you must: be an ECC student in good standing, have completed at least 12 units here at ECC, have a GPA of 2.5 or above, and be enrolled in at least six ECC units when taking the cross enrollment course.

To find out more about the CSULA program and the cross enrollment course, stop by our drop in hours in ARTB 320 on Tuesdays from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (third Tuesday of the month only a.m. drop in available).
