2018-19 Goals and Priorities**

The following goals and priorities will inform Board meeting and workshop agendas, strategies, and activities, and will be the criteria for the 2019 Board self-evaluation.

The Board is committed to fulfilling the Board Duties and Responsibilities per Board Policy 2200, with particular attention to the following:

1. Represent the public interest
2. Assure fiscal health and stability
3. Advocate for the district
4. Complete required training as mandated:
 - a. Ethics, per AB 1234
 - b. Sexual harassment, per AB 1825
5. Liaise frequently and responsibly with District communities
6. Review and adopt a procedure for Board Policy 2431 *Superintendent/President Selection*.

The Board is committed to its role related to leadership and support for College initiatives.

7. Expect and monitor the successful completion of the partnership between El Camino Community College District and the Compton Community College District.
8. Monitor the implementation of the Student Centered Funding Formula and expect that the District will maximize the resources available to serve students, with particular focus on:
 - a. Improving student success in graduation and transfer rates
 - b. Increasing the number of students who complete the FAFSA and access financial aid
 - c. Expanding high school and ECC partnerships that support access and success of students
 - d. Strengthening an integrated system of student support from initial engagement to completion through Guided Pathways and integrated plans relating to student success
 - e. Expanding innovative practices in online education and the adoption of open educational resources
9. Expect and monitor the expansion of educational programs and services in the community to support adult education and economic/workforce development.
10. Expect the full implementation of AB 705 and support the increased likelihood that students will complete transfer level math and English within one year.
11. Monitor the successful implementation of the El Camino College Educational and Facilities Master Plans.
