Board Policy 7335

Health Examinations

The Superintendent/President may require medical examinations of candidates for appropriate positions prior to assuming the duties of the position. Such pre-employment medical examinations shall be required of any candidate for a position for which a pre-employment medical examination has been deemed appropriate. No candidate shall be required to participate in such an examination on the basis of the candidate's age or disability.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent/President to require any employee to undergo a physical or mental examination at any time it appears to be in the District's interest to obtain verification of an employee's fitness for duty. Such medical examination shall be at the District's expense and shall be conducted by a physician chosen by the District.
