Why redistrict?

- ❖ ECCCD Trustee Area boundaries in 1947
- ❖ 1993 change to union high school districts in ECCCD

Why redistrict?

- ❖ **Federal Voting Rights Act**
- ❖ **California Voting Rights Act**

Current Population by Trustee Area

Area	Cities	Population
ONE	Inglewood, Ladera Heights, Windsor Hills	110,786
TWO	Alondra Park, Del Aire, Hawthorne, Lawndale, Lennox	156,894
THREE	Hermosa Beach, Redondo Beach, Manhattan Beach	117,294
FOUR	El Segundo	15,969
FIVE	Torrance	139,178

New Trustee Areas must contain 108,024

From At Large to Trustee Area Voting

- ❖ Currently, trustees must live in Trustee area they represent; voting is at-large
- ❖ For New Trustee Areas – voting by Trustee Area

The Boundary Review Process

- ❖ May - Board appointed seven-member Boundary Review Committee (BRC)

The Boundary Review Process

- ❖ BRC is to ensure election system is proportionate, fair, and consistent with “one person one vote”

- ❖ February – Board holds Public Hearing
- ❖ March – Board adopts new Trustee Areas

Next Steps (Proposed)

- ❖ May – Board submits proposal to BOG
 - AB 684 waiver
- ❖ New Trustee areas effective November 2013
