Introductions: René Lozano was introduced and welcomed as the faculty representative for ASB.

III. Approval of the Minutes (February 13, 2017) and Agenda:

IV. **Budget:**

Miriam Ifill presented the financials; Executive Summary, Expenses of Aux Services Special Request Account and income report. Cash available is \$136,247, ASB Fall 2016 Sticker Income was \$169,523 and balance left in the Special Request fund was \$7,015.

٧. ASO/ICC:

Araceli Rodriguez updated the committee on the Flowater hydration stations success. Associated Students Organization is considering to purchase panels to be placed on the side of the hydration stations to notify students that it was their Auxiliary Services Board sticker purchase that made it possible to purchase the hydration stations. Five ASO leadership students came back from American Student Association of Community Colleges Student Leadership Conference in Washington DC(Five students, two advisors). Rodriguez highlighted the congressional representatives they met and the bills they supported.

The committee asked Rodriguez if there were any further discussions by ASO to return some funds back to the ASB budget account since the fiscal year is ending soon and timing allows for ASO to re-consider returning funds to ASB. Rodriguez will ask the ASO President to consider the issue at the next executive committee meeting.

VI. Special Request Funding Presentation

Lozano discussed the proposal for \$2800 to the committee and the purpose of the Transfer Admit Fair. Event is a celebration of transfer for students of El Camino College. Twelve to 15 university reps on average come to the annual fair.

Motion made by Andrea Sala to approve the funding request for \$1,500 (one time funding), seconded by Araceli Rodriguez. Lozano recused himself from vote. Motion passed.
