Spring Flex/Professional Development Day



Three outstanding MESA students recently presented summer research findings at the Southern California Conference for Undergraduate Research (SCCUR). The conference provides a forum for the presentation of the best research, scholarship, and creative activities of undergraduate students in the region, and encourages communication of innovative achievements across disciplines.

ECC students Gabriela Moreno-Lopez, mechanical engineering major and Hector Flores, computer science major, conducted research in an intensive eight-week UCLA Transfer Student Summer Research Program (TSSRP) sponsored by Chevron. Moreno-Lopez's presentation is titled "Hydraulically actuated intervention system for MRI," and Flores' project is titled, "Human Activity Recognition Using Accelerometer and Gyroscope Data on the Wrist." Mariella Arias conducted research at Cornell University, where she worked on the project, "A Piezoelectric Material P(VDF-TrFE) Thin-Film Process Flow for Ultrasonic Transducers." All three students submitted abstracts to SC-CUR and were selected to present.
