El Camino College and the SBWIB

- With West LA College and the SBWIB, preparing Apprentices for Advanced Manufacturing & Bioscience Careers through a \$12 million U.S. Department of Labor grant
- With the SBWIB, partnered with Los Angeles Economic Development Corporate's Propel L.A. to develop a two-year program that works with underemployed and dislocated workers to prepare them for careers in advanced manufacturing
- Participates in the SBWIB's Aero-Flex Pre-Apprenticeship program, with all El Camino aerospace manufacturing students that enter an internship or co-op enrolling in Aero-Flex

El Camino College and the SBWIB

- SBWIB partners in El Camino's Aerospace Technician Apprenticeship program, with the 2-year apprenticeship program focusing on aerospace technician occupation in machining, electronics and engineering
- El Camino is participating in the SBWIB's Bio-Flex program, which will develop pre-apprenticeship and registered apprenticeship career pathways for the bioscience industry in Los Angeles County
- With the SBWIB, partnering to offer an training program that prepares young adults with disabilities to be entry-level CNC machinists and provides job placement support








Spring 2019 - Nearly 800 middle school students from Hawthorne School District hosted on campus through a partnership with CSUDH and Gear UP



Dual Enrollment with CVUHSD

- Hawthorne High School saw 11 students complete an ETEC (Engineering Technology) certificate with an additional 8 students near completion
- Partnership between Hawthorne PD and El Camino's Police Explorer Academy recruits students ages 14-20 from CVUHSD, with next class beginning Sept. 7
- Recently concluded 2nd year of offering dual enrollment as part of Volunteers of America Upward Bound and CSUDH Upward Bound Math & Science, with more than 40 students participating, mostly from CVUHSD
