El Camino College to Sponsor Planetarium Show & Telescope Viewing

The El Camino College astronomy department will sponsor two free planetarium shows and telescope viewing sessions, one at 5:30 and one at 7 p.m. on June 3. The event will begin in the campus planetarium, followed by a telescope viewing session on the roof of the math building starting at approximately 8:30 p.m., weather permitting. All events are free and open to the public – no reservations or tickets required.

The show will feature images provided by a brand new, state-of-the-art GOTO Chronos projector recently installed in the college planetarium. The nearly \$400,000 projector was purchased with funds from El Camino College's facilities bond (Measure E) and replaces the previous 35-year-old Spitz projector.

The new projector is widely considered the best in its class, showing accurate and sharp images of the night sky. Stars, planets, the Milky Way, and the moon are all visible at a moment's notice.

For those who have wondered what the Los Angeles night sky would look like if there were no light pollution, or which constellations are visible in the spring night sky, this show will answer such questions. Participants will also be able to discern stars from planets in the night sky, and can get a glimpse at how the sky will look like in 10,000 years from now.

The view of Saturn is expected to be spectacular this evening. All are welcome to come enjoy the skies, both the way the ancients did and in ways they could only dream about. The El Camino College planetarium is located on campus, 16007 Crenshaw Boulevard, near the intersection of Crenshaw and Manhattan Beach boulevards.
