El Camino College to Sponsor Transfer Conference

El Camino College's second annual Transfer Conference is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. April 21 at the Campus Theatre, 16007 Crenshaw Blvd., Torrance, CA 90506.

Last year nearly 350 students attended this event featuring various workshops on topics such as "Transfer Basics," "Transfer Strategies," and "Finishing the Transfer Process." Students can also participate in workshops on the various university segments: University of California, California State Universities, independent colleges and universities, and historically black colleges. A workshop for international students, and a transfer student panel of former El Camino College students who are attending or who have recently graduated from universities will also be available.
