The El Camino College journalism department recently collected 16 awards at the Journalism Association of Community Colleges (JACC) Southern California Conference earlier this month, competing against about 400 students from 26 community colleges. Of the 16 awards, *Warrior Life* won the General Excellence Award for magazines.

Approximately 20 ECC journalism students participated in on-the-spot writing, design and photography contests at the conference staged at California State University, Fullerton. They also attended workshops led by professional journalists, covering every aspect of the field.
