El Camino College will sponsor a conference on Nov. 19 for students interested in careers in science, technology, engineering and math fields.

The STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Math) Student Conference runs from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at El Camino College, and offers a professional development opportunity for students interested in pursuing an education or career in any of the STEM fields. From engineering to entomology, students will learn about the latest careers in STEM fields, and be provided with information about degree programs offered at El Camino College and four-year universities.

Conference participants will start the day at the Student Activities Center East Lounge with breakfast and workshops to follow in the Humanities Building.
