## **El Camino College to Present “A Tribute to Eva Brown: Reflections on Her Life”**

El Camino College will present “A Tribute to Eva Brown: Reflections on Her Life,” from 1-2 p.m. March 1 in the Library’s Distance Education Classroom, Room 166.

Mrs. Brown, who passed away in late December, survived Auschwitz and lost many of her extended family in the Holocaust. Her experiences were documented in her book, “If You Save One Life: A Survivor’s Memoir.” In addition to describing her concentration camp ordeals, the book provides inspiration through her message of peace and tolerance.

Mrs. Brown’s contributions to El Camino College are many; as one example, she established the Eva Brown Fund through the El Camino College Foundation and also contributed books and memorabilia from her personal collection to establish the Eva Brown Peace and Tolerance Collection on display in the El Camino College Schauerman Library. The college was also honored to have Mrs. Brown as the keynote speaker for commencement in 2006; her powerful story captivated the audience.

The Eva Brown event will include a reading from her book, as well as tributes from the Museum of Tolerance and friends and family members. The El Camino College Friends of the Library and the El Camino College Foundation are sponsors of the event, which also kicks off the college’s Women’s History Month celebration.
