UCLA Extension Courses Open for Spring 2015 at El Camino College *Classes begin January 5, 2015*

Start the New Year by accelerating your professional goals and enrolling in the UCLA Extension courses offered at El Camino College. Courses begin January 5, 2015 and are scheduled during the evening hours.

UCLA Extension offers courses taught by experienced instructors right on the El Camino College campus. The continuing education courses enable professionals to advance in their fields, remain current, contribute to their company's success, or transition to new opportunities. The courses and UCLA Extension certificates are in some of the fastest growing and better-paying professions and industries.

For those interested in science, math, and/or engineering, the **Spacecraft Attitude Control** course covers basic kinematics, dynamics, and linear control theory concepts in the study of satellite attitude control systems. This is an elective course for the UCLA Astronautical Engineering Certificate and is taught by Rongsheng "Ken" Li and David Needelman, technical fellows at Boeing.

Fundamentals of Project Management shows professionals how to use practical techniques to organize and control non-routine activities to properly manage and schedule quality, budget, and performance objectives. In **Project Earned Value, Procurement, and Cost Management**, students gain an understanding of theory and real-world applications, which increase their ability to plan and manage project performance and cost. Both courses are taught by Al Hirsch, managing director at CTARCo International.

Working with Boards and Volunteers is structured to teach leadership skills and provides strategies about how to create and sustain an efficient and successful board. Techniques and principles pivotal to the success of any business or non-profit organization are also covered.

Lean Operations is geared toward those with an interest in manufacturing and productivity. Taught by Saeed Madjidi, an instructor with experience as a senior lean consultant, the course implements the teaching of "lean" principles and applications in order to improve operations and promote quality products.

Introduction to Human Nutrition provides students with a background in the basics of nutrition and stresses the link between nutrition practices, health, disease, and exercise performance.
