El Camino College to Offer Summer Math Academies ECC Students and Incoming Freshmen to Benefit from Math Skills Instruction

El Camino College students and incoming freshmen will be offered a chance to brush up on their math skills this summer with the 2015 Summer Math Academies.

The three-week sessions teach students basic math skills, beginning algebra, intermediate algebra and precalculus. Other learning assets like time management and study skills will be practiced as well, said Malinni Roeun, ECC math instructor and organizer of the academies.

By attending one of the academies, students get a better chance at excelling in math courses offered at El Camino College and scoring higher on the College Mathematics Placement Test (CMPT), Roeun said.

Three sessions will begin May 21 and run through June 11. Another nine sessions will begin July 9 and finish July 30. Each academy meets Monday through Thursday for four hours.
