## **There is Still Time to Apply & Register for Fall 2015!** *Classes Added to Fall 2015 at El Camino College*

The Fall 2015 semester begins Aug. 22 at El Camino College and there is still time to apply and register for classes.

In addition, hundreds of classes were added for the Fall 2015 semester to help students meet their educational goals.

Now is the time to focus on your future! Students who earn a degree or certificate from one of the California Community Colleges nearly double their earnings within three years. Studies also show that Californians with a college degree will earn \$400,000 more in their lifetime than their peers with only a high school diploma.

Even students who are still in high school can get started on their college education at El Camino College – for FREE. Fees are waived on college classes for eligible juniors and seniors who want to earn college credits while still in high school. Students must be California residents to be eligible for a fee waiver. Students may also earn a degree or certificate by attending only evening and online classes.
