## **El Camino College Presents Annual Summer Kid's College Program** *Students in Grades 1-12 Can Register for Some Serious Summer Fun!*

The El Camino College Community Education Department presents its annual "Kid's College" summer program for children entering grades 1-12. The six-week program consists of three two-week sessions between June 22 and July 31. The Kid's College not-for-credit workshops, camps, and classes are designed for serious summer fun with an emphasis on inspiring a sense of wonder and imagination for learning.

Classes run Monday through Friday from 9-11:30 a.m. for grades one through five and 9:15-11:15 a.m. for grades six through 12. Afternoon classes are scheduled for 12:30-3 p.m. for grades one through five and 12:15-2:15 p.m. for grades six through eight. Aftercare is available for \$10 daily or \$30 weekly for grades one through eight until 4 p.m. All classes are located at El Camino College.

A sampling of the courses that will be offered include: Learning with Legos, Drums "R" Fun, Space Camp, Lil' Game Designer – Computer Programming, "Wow, Look What I Wrote Today!" Kid's Rock Guitar Camp, Adventures in Archeology, and Super Cool Math. Students in upper grades can enroll in screen writing, game designer – design & code your own video game, Pulitzer Prize journalism – Common Core news writing, English-Language training for English language learners, grammar, and pre-algebra. High school students can try algebra, SAT boot camp, geometry, and writing the high school essay.

All children from the community in grades one through 12 are invited to enroll. Registration is required: First session deadline is Thursday, June 11, second session deadline is Friday, June 26, and third session deadline is Friday, July 10, 2015.
