El Camino College Hires New Chief Technology Officer

El Camino College recently welcomed a new Chief Technology Officer to the Torrance-area campus.

Arthur Leible is the newest member of the El Camino College management team. He will be responsible for planning, implementing and maintaining the college's information systems to support academics, student services, and business operations for the campus that serves more than 25,000 students and 1,300 employees.

Leible will lead the Information Technology Services Division and provide direction in developing technology use on campus, while following the goals of the district's Technology Plan and implementing efficient use of technology resources.

ECC's network programming, security, project prioritization and management, implementation, shared information system interfaces, voice and data systems, data recovery, distance learning, hardware/software acquisition, Web services, and system design also will be supervised by Leible.

Leible comes to El Camino College after serving as a transition chief information officer at Ellucian, Inc., a provider of technology and outsourced software and services for higher education. In this position, he strategized, led, and managed all aspects of technology systems and services.

He also worked as the assistant vice chancellor of information technology at the Pima County Community College District in Arizona and as chief information officer at the Tucson Unified School District, among other positions in school-based technology.

Also a retired major, U.S. Army, Leible has a doctorate in business information systems from Northcentral University in Arizona; an MBA in business information systems from City University in Washington; and a bachelor's degree from the University of Wisconsin at Oshkosh.
