El Camino College Presents Annual Summer Kid's College Program NEW: Sizzling Summer Saturdays Added!

The El Camino College Community Education department presents its annual summer Kid's College program for children entering grades one through 12.

The six-week program consists of three two-week Monday through Friday sessions and six one-day Saturday sessions between June 27 and August 6. Kid's College not-for-credit workshops, one-day Saturday introductory camps, and weekday classes set for are designed for serious summer fun with an emphasis on inspiring a sense of wonder and imagination for learning.

New this summer is "Sizzling Summer Saturdays." In these one-day, fun-filled introductory workshop classes, youngsters will have the opportunity to discover new interests, pursue hobbies or tap into their creativity.

A sample list of the classes offered this summer include: Learning with Legos, Science Explorations, Math Amazing, Lil' Game Designer/Computer Programming, Wow – Look What I Wrote Today!, Kid's Rock Guitar Camp, and Musical Theatre Camp for grades one-five. For grades six through eight, Woodturning Workshop, Build A Robot: Vex Robotics, Veterinary Assistant Camp, Fencing Camp, Game Designer/Design & Code Your Own Video Game, Real Life English-Language Training For English Language Learners, Grammar Can Be Fun!, and Pre-Algebra are available. High school students can enroll in First Aid and CPR for Babysitters, Algebra, Algebra 2, SAT Boot Camp, Geometry, and Writing the High School Essay.

Morning and/or afternoon classes are available. Lunch supervision is provided for students in grades one through five who are enrolled for the full day. Classes are Monday through Friday from 9 to 11:30 a.m. for grades one through five and 9:15 to 11:15 a.m. for grades six through 12; afternoons 12:30 to 3 p.m. for grades one through five; and 12:15 to 2:15 p.m. for grades six through 12. Aftercare is available for \$10 daily or \$30 weekly for grades one through eight until 4 p.m. All classes are held on the El Camino College campus.

Registration is required. First session deadline is Thursday, June 16; second session deadline is Friday, July 1; and the third session deadline is Friday, July 15, 2016. Parents are encouraged to enroll now as classes fill quickly.
