El Camino College invites all new students to attend "New Student Welcome Day," an event designed to introduce students to campus and ease them into college life.

The free event is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Aug. 24 and will offer students a chance to tour the campus, learn about the many ECC programs and resources, and purchase textbooks at the El Camino College Bookstore. Additional student services will be open until 4:30 p.m.

Students will also be able to complete the required steps to enrollment with opportunities to attend an orientation, take college placement tests, meet with a counselor, and create an educational plan.

"You can get a feel for the campus, take a tour, and find out where your classes are. Lunch will be provided at the event, with lunchtime music by radio station Power 106.

Participants at New Student Welcome Day will also attend a variety of workshops covering topics such as financial aid and scholarships, transfer opportunities, student life, campus safety, library resources, transitioning into college, and other support programs. Major-specific workshops will be offered by ECC professors and registration assistance will be available in the library.

"New Student Welcome Day offers students the opportunity to get to know the campus before the first day of the fall semester," said El Camino College President Dena P. Maloney. "It is also an opportunity to learn about all of the remarkable academic and support programs that we have at El Camino College."

Ivan recommends that incoming students get acquainted with the campus and then look into joining programs and clubs.

"You will want to get involved in campus life, have fun, meet new friends, and take advantage of other opportunities that are available to you," he added.
