## Apply Now for Summer and Fall 2016 at El Camino College Earlier Registration Available to New Students

Applying now has its benefits: all new students in the El Camino Community College District are eligible for priority registration this summer and fall if they complete all four steps to enroll before March 31, 2016. **APPLY** New and returning students must complete an application

**PREPARE** All new students must participate in an orientation session and are encouraged

to take advantage of practice placement tests

**TEST** Assessment testing must be completed prior to registering for classes

**PLAN** Students must see a counselor prior to registration to develop an education plan
