## **Free Summer College Classes Available at El Camino College to Eligible High School Juniors and Seniors**

High school students can get started on their college education at El Camino College this summer.

**Free summer classes** are available to eligible juniors and seniors who want to earn college credits while still in high school. Students must be California residents to be eligible for a fee waiver.
