El Camino College to Present a Duo Piano Recital *Faculty members Polli Chambers-Salazar and Lois Roberts team up for an evening of classical music*

El Camino College music faculty members Polli Chambers-Salazar and Lois Roberts will team up for a “Duo Piano Recital” at 5 p.m. Nov. 19 in Marsee Auditorium.

Chambers-Salazar and Roberts will perform arrangements of “Ballet” from “Orphée et Eurydice” by composer Christoph Willibald Gluck; Souvenirs, Op. 28 by Samuel Barber; “Ma Mere L’Oye” by Maurice Ravel; and Suite No. 2, Op. 17 by Sergei Rachmaninov.

Chambers-Salazar has been teaching in El Camino College’s Music Department for more than eight years and is the author of a technical guidebook for beginning and advanced pianists. Her accomplishments include performing in venues throughout the U.S. and Canada, receiving awards in competitions such as the Simon-Fiset Competition, the New Orleans International Piano Competition, and the Seattle Young Artists Festival. She has also appeared on KCBS-TV, KUSC Classical Radio, and has even compiled her own CD of classical works.

Roberts specializes in classical repertoire, solo, chamber and orchestral music. She entered The Juilliard School at the age of 11 after her New York Town Hall debut. She studied with Josef Raieff, Albert Fuller, Guido Agosti, and Konrad Wolff. In addition to her degrees from Juilliard, she was awarded the Diploma di Merito at the Accademia Musicale Chigiana in Siena, Italy. She has played throughout the U.S. and Europe and has taught at American Boychoir School and Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey.
