El Camino College Concert Band to Perform Fall Concert

The El Camino College Concert Band will perform at 3 p.m. Nov. 20 in Marsee Auditorium. The Concert Band, made up of students and community members, regularly performs traditional and contemporary wind band music.

Directed by Dane Teter, El Camino College's director of instrumental music, the band will perform Frank Ticheli's "Simple Gifts," Rob Romeyn's "Apollo: Myth and Legend" and Samuel Hazo's "Across the Halfpipe," among other selections.

Professor Teter conducts the college's Concert Band and the Symphony Orchestra. He received his doctorate in music education from USC and is a veteran conductor who has worked with numerous bands, orchestras, and choirs from all over the Western United States. He frequently performs in El Camino College Artist-in-Residence recitals with fellow faculty members and local musicians.
