The Women of Distinction Award recognizes outstanding women from the El Camino College area, honoring them for their contributions to the community. Honorees are selected by the committee each year during March – Women's History Month.

Award nominations may be made by friends, family, and colleagues; or individuals may nominate themselves. Nominees will be judged for their contributions in the following areas that align with this year's National Women's History Month theme, *Honoring Trailblazing Women in Labor & Business*: professional accomplishments; leadership and/or mentorship; and social, educational, or health services.
