Traditional and Modern Works Highlight ECC Piano/Flute Recital Kristi Lobitz, piano, to perform with flutist Susan Greenberg

El Camino College music instructor and celebrated pianist Kristi Lobitz will join guest artist and accomplished flutist Susan Greenberg in a recital of traditional and modern works scheduled for 8 p.m. Jan. 26 in the Campus Theatre.

Lobitz has performed internationally in England, Canada, and Mexico and her collaborations feature accomplished ensembles such as the Conejo Valley Symphony of Thousand Oaks, the El Camino College Symphony Orchestra, and Pasadena's Repertoire Chamber Orchestra. She has a bachelor's degree from California Lutheran University and a master's degree from USC. Lobitz also attended Schiller College in Berlin, where she studied with Hans-Erich Riebensahm, a longtime faculty member of the Berlin Conservatory.

Flutist Susan Greenberg enjoys a versatile career as soloist, chamber musician, symphony player and recording artist. She joined the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra in 1975 and since then has been a frequent soloist on both flute and piccolo. Greenberg has performed with the Los Angeles Philharmonic, LA Opera, New York City Opera, American Ballet Theater and the Joffrey Ballet, as well as at the Casals, Ojai, and Martha's Vineyard music festivals.
