El Camino College to Present the Allant Trio Piano and string ensemble to perform works by Brahms, Haydn and Ravel

The vibrant ensemble Allant Trio will captivate audiences with classical chamber music from composers Brahms, Haydn and Ravel at 8 p.m. July 13 in El Camino College's Campus Theatre.

Allant Trio formed at The Julliard School in New York, where they received the prestigious Madrigano Entrepreneurship Grant. Trio performers include pianist Beth Nam, violinist Elizabeth Larson and cellist Jacob Braun.

Winners of the prestigious Beverly Hills Auditions in Los Angeles in 2013, the trio has participated in several prestigious international competitions, including the Melbourne International Chamber Music Competition, the International Chamber Music Competition in Hamburg, and the Trondheim International Chamber Music Competition in Norway, where they were named semifinalists.

The trio has since held their debut recital at Carnegie Hall and has performed at the Yehudi Menuhin Chamber Music Festival in San Francisco, the Banff Centre in Canada and the Norfolk Chamber Music Festival in Connecticut.
