El Camino College to Present Annual Summer Kid's College Program *"Sizzling Summer Saturdays" return to summer lineup!*

The El Camino College Community Education department will present its annual summer Kid's College program for children entering grades one through 12. The six-week program consists of three two-week morning and/or afternoon weekday sessions to choose from, in addition to several one-day Saturday sessions between June 26 and August 5.

Kid's College not-for-credit workshops, one-day Saturday camps and weekday classes are designed for serious summer fun with an emphasis on inspiring a sense of wonder and imagination for learning.

Classes offered this summer include: Kid's College Chefs, Minecraft Designers, Science Explorations, Cartooning & Drawing, Academic Chess, Kid's Rock Guitar Camp, and Musical Theatre Camp for grades one through five.

For grades six through eight, students can try Video Game Animation, Creative Writing, The Voice/Singing Class, and basketball and volleyball camps. High school students may enroll in SAT Boot Camp, Math Tutoring, and Writing the High School Essay, among other selections.

Morning and/or afternoon classes are available. Lunch supervision is provided for students in grades one through five who are enrolled for the full day.
