El Camino College Theatre Department to Present "Does a Tiger Wear a Necktie?"

The El Camino College Theatre Department will present the play "Does a Tiger Wear a Necktie?" in the Campus Theatre. Performances are scheduled for 8 p.m. March 24, 25, 31 and April 1. A matinee performance is set for 3 p.m. April 2.

The play was written in 1969 by Don Petersen and follows the story of teen drug addicts in a rehabilitation center and their encounters with racism, isolation and the lack of help for struggling addicts to get clean. The play debuted on Broadway and helped launch the career of actor Al Pacino, who won a Tony Award for his portrayal of the character Bickham.

The El Camino College production is directed by Jerry Prell.
