El Camino College to Sponsor Transfer Conference

University-bound students are invited to "TC-3 ... Blast-off to the University," El Camino College's third annual Transfer Conference. The event is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. May 11 at the Campus Theatre, 16007 Crenshaw Blvd., Torrance, CA 90506.

For the past two years, the event has drawn hundreds of students who attended various workshops, met with university representatives, and listened to panel discussions – all designed to get them on track to transfer to a four-year college or university.

Some workshop titles planned for the conference include: Starting the Transfer Process, Choosing a University, How to Pay for a Four-year College (financial aid information), and Why Choose a UC, CSU, Private College, or Historically Black College with a panel of university representatives from the various university systems.

Students can also sit in on panel discussions featuring former El Camino College students who transferred to various universities, and separate panels with representatives from various University of California, California State University, and private university campuses.

Outside the Campus Theater, a "University Fair" will be set up with a variety of university representatives ready to answer questions and hand out information. Raffles prizes are also part of the festivities.
