El Camino College Business Training Center Offers Free Job Skills Assessment Program to Area Businesses

The El Camino College Business Training Center's Work Ready Certificate program is available at no charge to employers who need people with the right skills, training and education. The program is based on the WorkKeys System, a nationally-recognized job analysis, skills assessment and training program that accurately measures an individual's skills and the competency levels required for successful job performance.

The program is computer-based and will be administered at Workforce Investment Board One-Stop locations throughout the South Bay and surrounding regions. Job applicants will be tested in the areas of applied mathematics, reading for information, and locating information.

Individuals who pass the certification will receive a list of employers who participate in the Work Ready Certificate program. In addition, participating employers can send applicants that they are considering for employment for testing. Applicants who do not pass the certification will have an opportunity to take remedial online tutoring to increase his or her skill level.

The Work Ready Certificate program is grant-funded which allows the El Camino College Business Training Center to offer the service at no charge.
