Clickers are now available for any ECC instructor who wishes to use them. ECC has adopted the TurningPoint XR clickers as the campus standard. These clickers allow you to easily record and examine every student's answer to a variety of question types, including simple multiple-choice, generic word, numbers/decimals, and putting lists in order. The results are immediately tabulated and can be displayed if the instructor wishes. Because the software is built around PowerPoint and Office, there's almost no new software to learn.
