**All new, incoming students are required to complete the CORE services of:**

## **1. Orientation**

- Students can access the online orientation through MyECC. Limited in-person orientations are offered through the Counseling Office and the Outreach and School Relations Office.

## **2. Educational Planning/Counseling Services**

- The Counseling Office is located in the Student Services Center, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor. Counseling appointments may be scheduled on MyECC each Thursday at 5 pm for the following week.

## **3. Assessment**

- Visit the Assessment/Testing Center in the Student Services Center Room 217 or online for test prep resources.

**After completing 15 units or prior to the end of the third semester, all students must declare a major and complete a comprehensive educational plan.**
