a guide to providing information to the Daily Breeze.

WHO TO CALL: The Breeze sports department at 310-543-6177

WHEN TO CALL: Anytime after 6 p.m. on a weekday or 4 p.m. on Saturdays. Winter sports can create a logjam of calls coming at the same time later in the night, so please be patient. We might put you on hold, but we'll get to you as quickly as possible.

WHAT

WE NEED: The necessary information varies with the sport. The more specifics you can offer, the more complete the account of the game can appear in the paper. Have rosters for both teams with correct spellings of names. First and last names are needed for all players mentioned. Here are some tips for specific winter sports.

BASKETBALL: Scoring by quarters, team totals, three-point baskets, rebounds, steals and assists as well as overall and league records of each team.

SOCCER: Final score, individual scoring, including name of scorer, the minute scored and person who assisted. For shutouts, the name of the

goalkeeper and the number of saves made/season shutout total and league and overall records for each team.

WRESTLING: Final meet score, scores of each match, times of pins and records for each team and overall and league records for each team.

GIRLS WATER POLO: Final score, goal scorers and other stats, including steals and assists, goalkeeper blocks and league and overall records for each team.

IMPORTANT: Please be patient, particularly on Thursday and Friday nights, because of the high number of events involved. The earlier you call, the quicker your information can be taken
