READ THE OTHER SIDE!

HTP REQUIREMENT:

Honors students must complete at least one honors course each semester, and a minimum of five honors courses to complete the program. Students should consult with a counselor to ensure that they take the appropriate courses for their major and transfer institution.

New students are required to complete English 1A by the end of their first semester in the program. Honors English 1A is recommended.

Above is a list of currently offered honors courses. Most of these courses are offered during both the fall and spring semesters. Since all sections of a course offered are not honors sections, students in the HTP must be sure that they **enroll in sections listed in the Schedule of Classes under the heading, *Honors Transfer Program***.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- No more than two of the English courses listed above may count toward the minimum of five honors courses required for program completion.
- No more than two of the science/mathematics courses listed below may count toward the minimum of five honors courses required for program completion.

Biology 101 (1A) and 102 (1B)	Introductory Biology I; and II
Chemistry 1A and 1B	General Chemistry I; and II
Computer Science 1	Problem Solving and Program Design Using C++
Mathematics 190 and 191	Single Variable Calculus and Analytic Geometry I; and II
Physic 1A and 1B	Mechanics of Solids; Fluid, Heat and Sound

All sections of these science/math courses are considered honors courses, although they are not designated as such in the Schedule of Classes. These courses are primarily for students majoring in science, mathematics, or engineering.

Note: For Summer 2009, we might offer several HTP courses, depending on program funding.
