**EDUCATION 210 - ETUDES INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION (2 Units)** **Section #8509**

**3-Week Class: 10/5/09 -10/22/09 (Mon. & Thur., 3-6pm, + online work)**

This course covers the basic tools and features of ETUDES-NG, the online course management system used by West Los Angeles College and many other colleges, including ITV, Mission College, Los Angeles City College, Harbor College, East Los Angeles College, and Valley College. Successful completion of this course is required to teach online or hybrid classes. *This course meets face-to-face two times a week for three weeks. It is delivered in a hybrid format that includes face-to-face sessions and online work.*

**EDUCATION 240 - ONLINE PEDAGOGY (3 Units)** **Section #8212**

**4-Week Class: 11/2/2009 - 11/27/2009**

This course focuses on “how to teach online.” Regardless of which learning management system you use, this course addresses how to develop and deliver classes that lead to student success. Best practices for both online students and instructors are covered, along with discussions of relevant online and adult learning theories and associated activities. The various delivery methods of computer-mediated instruction, such as fully online courses, hybrid courses, and Web-enhanced courses are compared and contrasted.

**EDUCATION 230 - ONLINE STUDENT SUCCESS LAB (1 Unit)** **Section #8211**

**3-Week Class: 11/2/09 - 11/22/09**

This course also serves new online instructors to better empathize with and ensure the success of their online students.
