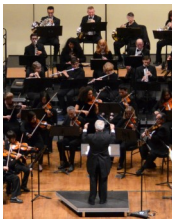

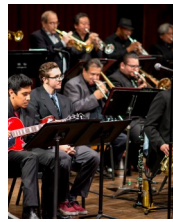

Performing arrangements from the great composers & bandleaders from the jazz tradition in the style of Count Basie, Duke Ellington, Oliver Nelson and more!

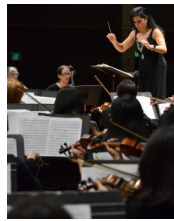
